


## ZEV sales in Canada




#### Canada's public ZEV charging infrastructure requirements

# Economic implications




- The economic consequences of the federal ZEV mandate are severe.
  According to recent analysis in the *Canadian Journal of Economics*:
  - "If the mandate outpaces achievement of cost parity the economic consequences can be severe and would likely cause the auto manufacturing sector to shut down"
- According to the modelling, the EV mandate will push the Canadian automobile industry into a large loss position and negatively affect the growth of the wider economy.
- Estimated economic losses: 4.8 per cent reduction in real GDP nationally (8.9 per cent in Ontario), and 2.6 per cent cut in real earnings per worker.
